

Ed-Fi Benefits for Assessment Providers & Agencies


The Ed-Fi Alliance provides powerful standards-based interoperability capabilities that solve multiple use cases for a variety of entities: LEAs, SEAs, district collaboratives and educational service centers, higher education institutions, community partners, application providers, system integrators and vendors.

These entities utilize the Ed-Fi Technology Suite for real-time or near real-time data flow exchanged among applications, and for data architecture purposes (e.g. integrating data from source applications, supporting data management and governance, data analysis, and data visualization/reporting). The Ed-Fi Data Standard, APIs, and supporting technologies support these priorities and needs.

Timely Data to Assessment Providers

Specific to assessment data and assessment providers, education agencies in the Ed-Fi Community seek to use assessment data alongside other source system data to create holistic views of learners' progress, performance, and needs. Ed-Fi based architectures can provide quality, timely data to assessment providers through the API as well as for the management and rapid delivery of assessment results data.
